M: Great! I think we've got it here. Just one more question: Do you remember where you lost it?

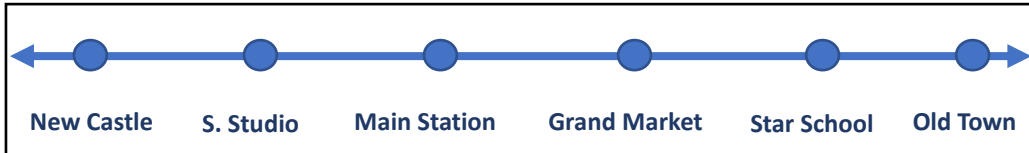
W: I'm not sure where exactly, but it should be somewhere between Old Town and Main Station, where I travel from home to work every day.
